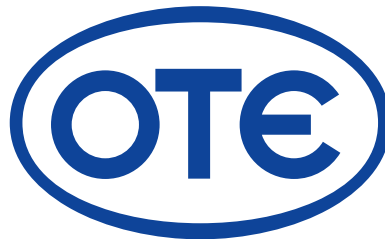

Kusadasi

Kusadasi is the most tourist area of Turkey after Constantinoupolis. There is a market where you can find several sort of goods. Famous is the "bazaar of price", never buy something at the original price, normally it costs half the money and you have to bargain before you pay. In shops in Kusadasi you can pay either in euro or with any other coin, credit cards are accepted.
